

2021 SAINTE ROSE PINOT NOIR

Racines is a collaboration by two classic houses from France, led by Etienne de Montille and Brian Sieve of Burgundy and Rodolphe Peters of Champagne. The team came together to join their individual experiences in hand-crafting wines of purity and transparency to create a range of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay from the cool climate of the Sta. Rita Hills in California.

VINEYARDS

This wine is sourced from well established, reputable vineyards within the Sta. Rita Hills, including Sanford & Benedict, La Rinconada and Rancho La Viña. The vineyard sites for this cuvée's third bottling are all located off of Santa Rosa Road, or its French translation, Sainte Rose.

PRODUCTION

The favorable growing conditions of the vintage rewarded us with the ability to blend some of each vineyard's best barrels. In the cellar, 50% whole cluster was retained and fermented with a combination of foulage and pigeage before being put to 228L barriques.
